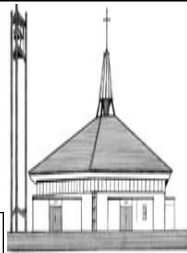

All Ireland Rosary Rally - Knock - Saturday June 1st: Join thousands of people from around Ireland and beyond for the All Ireland Rosary Rally on June 1st. The day begins at 9.30am with a Conference in St. John's Centre. Speakers include Fr. Brendan Kilcoyne, Fr. Joseph Mary Deane CFR, and Sr. Ana Margarita Lanzas SCTJM. Then there is a chance to meet over 20 apostolates from around Ireland in St. John's Centre from 11.30am.
