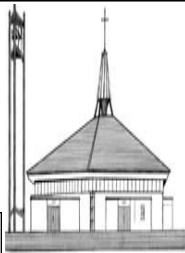

Feast of Saints Peter and Paul – Saturday 29th June: The Church celebrates the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul to honor the two great apostles. St. Peter, one of the twelve and the Chief of the Apostles, the Rock upon which Christ built His Church, and Saint Paul “called to be an apostle, set apart for the gospel of God” and Apostle to the Gentiles. Together they are honored as founders of the Church of Rome, having been separately martyred there during the reign of the Emperor Nero. Christian tradition has always considered Saint Peter and Saint Paul to be inseparable: indeed, together, they represent the whole Gospel of Christ.
