The Brown Scapular

1. What is the Brown Scapular?

The Brown Scapular is a small garment made of two pieces of brown wool, joined by strings and worn over the shoulders. It was first made known by Our Lady Herself, July 16th 1251, to St. Simon Stock.

2. What is Our Lady's Scapular promise?

In revealing the significance of the Scapular, Our Lady spoke as follows: 'Receive this habit of your Order; this shall be to you and to all Carmelites a privilege that "WHOSOEVER DIES CLOTHED IN THIS HABIT SHALL NEVER SUFFER ETERNAL FIRE".

3. What does the Promise mean?

Our Lady does not mean by Her promise that those who die in mortal sin will be saved. The Promise means that anyone in Mary's family or Confraternity will receive through Her, at the hour of death, the grace to die well.

4. What is necessary in order to die a member of Our Lady's Confraternity?

In order so to die, it is necessary that we be validly enrolled in the Confraternity, that we have worn the Scapular faithfully in life, and above all that our manner of life has been worthy of Jesus Christ and His Blessed Mother. Because "by Her motherly love, Mary cares for the brethren of Her Son who still journey on earth surrounded by dangers and difficulties, until they are led to their happy home in Heaven."
