

Training for Parish Pastoral Councils: Over the past number of months and following on from our Diocesan Assembly, the Diocesan Pastoral Council (DPC) engaged with representatives of Parish Pastoral Councils throughout the Diocese and assimilated the many and varied responses in the feedback given. One of the main concerns in the very positive feedback was the need for the establishment of and support for Parish Pastoral Councils throughout the Diocese. This must be coupled with effective training and the provision of educational material that would assist in the establishment and on-going formation of Parish Pastoral Councils. After much research, a comprehensive training manual Norms for Parish Pastoral Councils has been produced by the DPC and will be available to every parish and Parish Pastoral Council in the Diocese from 1st February, 2025. We believe the manual needs to be accompanied by adequate training to make the working of PPCs more effective.

A number of people throughout the diocese, who will offer training to clusters of parishes in each deanery, are themselves being trained. You will receive an invitation to a training session

in your deanery. We aim to have all pastoral councils in place by March 15th and training will begin towards the end of March. All new Parish Pastoral Councils will be commissioned in the Cathedral on Pentecost Sunday.

Catholic Schools Week 2025 - Alive in Christ! Catholic Schools Week 2025 will be celebrated from Sunday 19th January to Saturday 25th January, with the theme of Catholic Schools: Alive in Christ.
