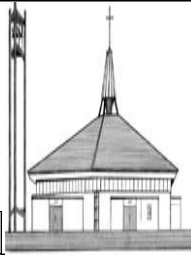

These railings help people who are elderly or disabled to ascend the steps and descend the steps. It sometimes happens that people gather outside the Church after Mass for conversation. Please make sure you are distanced from the railings as there are people who need to use them.

**Divine Mercy Sunday:** The Sunday after Easter Sunday is designated as Divine Mercy Sunday, that is Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> April. At 3.00 pm in St. Mary's Church, Cloone, we will expose the Blessed Sacrament. During the exposition the rosary will be recited and the chaplet of Divine Mercy will be recited. Participants are encouraged to receive confession before Easter, preferably; receive Holy Communion on the day of the Feast; and venerate the Image of Divine Mercy by bowing before it and saying "Jesus I trust in you." The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed at 4.00 pm.
