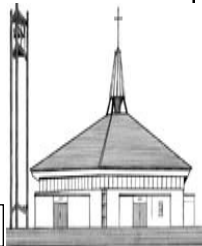

**The Season of Creation** runs from 1st September (World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation) to 4th October (Feast of St Francis of Assisi.) Catholics are encouraged to organise prayer and practical initiatives to combat the environmental crisis. It is a time for our Churches to value and thank God for the gifts of Creation. Pope Leo XIV's message for World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation on 1st September is **Seeds of Peace and Hope**. In this Jubilee Year, Pope Leo celebrated the first **Mass for the Care of Creation** on 9th July, with prayers that we will "lovingly care" for creation and "learn to live in harmony with all creatures". The theme of Season of Creation this year is: **Peace with Creation**. It highlights that natural ecosystems, such as forests and wetlands, are destroyed or degraded by conflict—a mounting problem in our world today. Wars divert political attention and financial resources away from climate action and environmental protection. In many countries, clean energy projects and conservation efforts are delayed or defunded as governments shift priorities toward military spending and crisis management. Despite the focus of many Christian services on a Eucharistic meal and celebrating the gifts of creation, too often Christians have alienated themselves from the natural world. Perhaps during the Season of Creation we could revive saying Grace before family and community meals to recover our appreciation of the food provided by the natural world.
