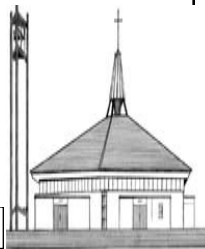

Divine Mercy Sunday: The Sunday after Easter Sunday is designated as Divine Mercy Sunday, that is Sunday 12th April. At 3.00pm in St. Mary's Church, Cloone, we will expose the Blessed Sacrament. During the exposition the rosary will be recited and the chaplet of Divine Mercy will be recited. Participants are encouraged to receive confession before Easter, preferably; receive Holy Communion on the day of the feast; and venerate the Image of Divine Mercy by bowing before it and saying "Jesus I trust in you." Bóthar Na Naomh Trail extension The Bóthar Na Naomh Recreational, Sports, Heritage and Nature Trail with your help, want to take the next step and extend the trail past Cloone GAA park to the historic Creigharee Ancient Holy Well. The Department of Rural and Community Development (DRCDG) has recently approved grant aid of €200,000 under the Outdoor Recreation Infrastructure Scheme to assist us in this development. The total project cost is €222,222 (inclusive of VAT and Leitrim Development Company's Administration fees). Our local community must provide 10% match funding of €22,222.20 to support the delivery of this project. An online fundraising campaign is presently under way to assist with this click on QR code.
