October—Mission Month: In his message for Mission Sunday the Pope says “As they travel through the streets of the world, the disciples of Jesus need to have a love without limits, the same measure of love that our Lord has for all people. We proclaim the most beautiful and greatest gifts that he has given us: his life and his love”. The Irish missionary disciples need our spiritual and financial help today. We have some 1,200 men and women working in all corners of the world, each playing his or her part on the missionary journey.

The Holy Souls: At this time of the year on 1st November, we celebrate the Feast of All Saints, all those who are part of the Communion of Saints and are interceding for us. On 2nd November we pray for the Holy Souls, the souls in Purgatory.

After death when we stand before the face of God, not only will all the good things we have done be revealed to us, but also the imperfections of our lives, the unrepented sins, the good things we have failed to do.

Then we will have only one desire—to be healed and transformed and to be able to love God as he loves us. Only with the prayers and sacrifices of people who are still here on earth can we be helped to receive the purification that Divine mercy brings. Our affection for those who belong to us continues after they die. We show this affection for the Holy Souls by our sacrifices for them and our prayer for them. To pray for the souls of the faithful departed is a work of mercy, and we are never closer to them and more supportive of them than when we attend Mass for their benefit. Also, the Holy Souls can help us.

St. John Vinney, the Curé of Ars said “If we only knew what power these good souls have over the heart of God and what graces we can receive through their intercession, they would not be so abandoned by us. The prayer for their release from Purgatory is, after the prayer for the conversion of sinners, the most pleasing prayer to God.
