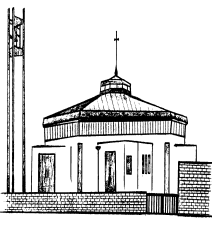

Save Aughavas P.O.: An Post is now holding a public consultation to determine the fate of Aughavas post office. Cloone Tidy Towns Committee trail project: Cloone Tidy Towns Committee are currently proceeding with the next phase of Bóthar na Naomh Recreation Heritage & Nature Trail which entails a looped trail around Annaghmacooney lake linking up with existing trail, fishing points and access for vehicles to the lake shore. Funding of €113,659.59 is being provided by the Department of Arts, Heritage, Regional, Rural & Gaeltacht Affairs and Inland Fisheries Ireland for this project. To comply with conditions set for this grant aid the application details have been placed on the Public Procurement website www.etenders.gov.ie. Suitably qualified interested tenderers, if not already done so, must register as suppliers and make an expression of interest for the project on the website in order to participate in the tender process.
