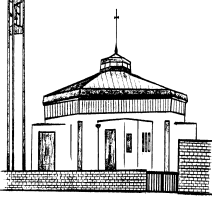

Feast of Corpus Christi, 18th June 2017: The Feast of Corpus Christi honours the presence of Christ in the Eucharist. This year we will have a Corpus Christi procession in Aughavas. The purpose of a Corpus Christi procession is to adore Christ present in the Eucharist, to give thanks for the presence of Christ in the Eucharist, and to ask blessings upon our Parish. The Eucharist in the monstrance will be carried in the procession. The procession will begin immediately after 11.30 am Mass. It will go down through the old road and return through the old cemetery, back to the Church, where we will have Benediction. The procession will take approximately 25 minutes. The Rosary will be recited along the route. Everyone is welcome to take part. If you are at Mass on 18th June and you are not going in the procession, please do not move a car until the procession has moved on to the old road. Also, if you are not able to go in the procession, you may remain in the Church until the procession returns.
