White Fathers Mission Appeal: The White Fathers are speaking at all Masses next weekend and they are making their Mission Appeal. The White Fathers were founded in Algeria in 1868. They are still present and preaching the Gospel in 24 African and Middle-Eastern countries. There are today 500 young men in seminaries, mainly in Africa, preparing to become Missionaries of Africa. They are appealing for funds to help in the work of preparing people to be apostles in the Africa of the future.
