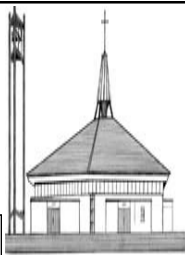

Confession

*How great is the light that shines out from the Cross! It tells us that our separation from God was ended at that moment when **The Son of God offered Himself for our sins and died praying to God for our forgiveness. No crime or blasphemy of ours can exceed the forgiveness of Christ. Even the condemned criminal who repents is promised: 'This day you will be with me in Paradise' (LK 23:43). Hence the message for all of us: Take heart! In the Cross this offer of salvation is held out to every one of us. Yet everyone must still lay down their own burden of sins at the foot of the Cross and bend the knee before the infinite Mercy of Jesus - which in practice means a sincere sacramental Confession with true repentance and an honest intention to sin no more. Even though we know that on account of our weaknesses we will inevitably fall again, nevertheless, each one of us must take this step in Confession. The time has come to learn a new appreciation of this sacrament, which is in practice the quintessence of the Cross.***
