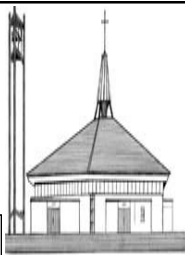

Hedge Cutting Grant Scheme 2019—Leitrim County Council invites Applications for the Hedge Cutting Grant Scheme 2019. This Scheme aims to encourage Landowners and Local Communities/Residents to cut roadside hedges/trees along the Public Road Network. The Grant is €75 per km of roadside hedge/overhanging trees which are cut back. The Minimum length of roadside hedges to be cut is 2km per application.
