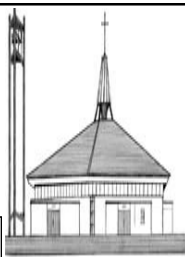

Aughavas Parish Improvements Scheme: Presently we have a number of Job vacancies in the Aughavas - Cloone area. Please check on jobsireland.ie for further details. Please contact your local DEASP Employment Services/Intreo Office (Carrick on Shannon (071) 965 0070) to check your eligibility and to apply for this vacancy. Job Reference Number will be required. Eligibility to participate on CE is generally linked to those who are 21 years or over for the Childcare, Health and Social Care sectors and 25 years of age or over for all other areas. Applicants must also be in receipt of an Irish social welfare payment for 1 year or more.

The wearing of face coverings in Church: It remains our responsibility to ensure that our services of worship are safe places for all who join with us.
