

Diocesan Assembly: The Diocesan Assembly took place on Sat May 14th last. Thank you to the many delegates from the 41 parishes of the diocese who took part in the task of trying to discern pastoral priorities for the years ahead. Since September 2019 the delegates were invited to take part in a listening process throughout the diocese. Over the first few months, delegates worked with a wide and varied group of people, to look at their needs and what parish meant for them today. Some of those who took part were involved in parish life and others were not; there were also a good many individual submissions received from people throughout the diocese over this period of time. From these submissions a number of pastoral priorities were identified as follows:

- Mission to youth.
- Mission to families.
- Mission for lay formation.

Subsequent to the beginning of the assembly process, Pope Francis invited submissions from around the world in a Synodal pathway. The work and viewpoints that were shared at the assembly over the last two years have been compiled to form the basis of our submission to the Synodal pathway. This submission will be available on the diocesan website ardgahdiocese.org. The steering committee will address the task of implementing some of the recommendations in the near future.
