- 2. Do one thing at a time and attempt to give it your full attention.
- 3. Pause now and then throughout the day and take a few moments of silence. Ask yourself, "what is happening within me at this moment?" What am I observing in myself? In those around me?
- 4. How am I experiencing the movement of God's spirit at this time?
- 5. Is there anything I'm struggling to let go of?
- 6. What "heartbreak" of the world do I wish to call to mind?
- 7. Is anything being asked of me at this moment?
