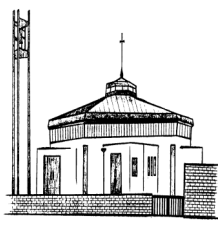

The Meaning of Marriage: Legislation Relating to Marriage in Ireland: As the Northern Catholic Bishops affirmed in an open letter on 28th April 2014 to all Members of the Legislative Assembly of Northern Ireland with regard to their debate on this issue, the 'marriage of a woman and a man is a fundamental building block of society which makes a unique and irreplaceable contribution to the common good and to society as well. It is therefore deserving of special recognition and promotion by the State'. The Constitution of Ireland regards the family 'as the necessary basis of social order and as indispensable to the welfare of the Nation and the State' (Art. 41.1.2). 'The State pledges itself to guard with special care the institution of Marriage, on which the Family is founded, and to protect it against attack (Art. 41.3.1). Any attempt to change this protection would be a radical change in the meaning of marriage—the 'foundation stone' of society—in the document that expresses the foundational values of the Irish State.
